 our seals and Dated the 3th Day of April 1746.

 Credits of Richard Lewis late of the parish of Llanblethian in the County of Glamorgan
 Bachelor Deceased~~

do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all singular the Goods Chattels Credits of the S^r. deceased w^{ch} have
 or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Margarett and Elizabeth
 or into the hands possession of any other person or persons for them and the same so made
 exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the Consistory Court of St. Andrew at or before the 8th
 day of July next ensuing and the same Goods Chattels Credits & all other the Goods Chattels Credits
 and all other the Goods Chattels Credits of the S^r. deceased at the time of his Death or w^{ch} at any other
 time after shall come to the hands possession of the said Margarett and Elizabeth
 or into the hands possession of any other person or persons for them do well
 truly administer according to Law further to make or cause to be made a true & just account of their said
 Administration at or before the 8th day of April w^{ch} shall be in the year 1747
 and all the Rest Residue of the S^r. Goods Chattels Credits w^{ch} shall be found remaining upon the said
