

The will of Stephen Nicholls, gentleman, of Llanblethian, dated 22nd., September 1730.

To the churchwardens and overseers of the poor of Llanblethian £5 to be put to interest the profits being distributed to the poor of the parish at Christmas.

His messuages, lands and tenements to his daughter Elizabeth Nicholls and her heirs for ever. Elizabeth to be sole executrix.

Proved 15th., September 1763 Elizabeth Nicholls, spinster, having died - the sole executrix now being her aunt Joan Deere, widow.

In The Name of God. Am 21, I Stephen Nicholls  
of the parish of Llandaff in the County of Glamorgan  
Gentleman, being of sound and perfect mind memory and  
understanding, do make and ordain this my last will  
and testament in manner and forme following (That is  
to say) Imprimis I give and bequeath unto the  
Churchwardens and overseers of the poor of the parish of  
Llandaff in the said County for the time being the sum of  
five pounds to be paid by my Executor hereinafter named  
within six months after my decease, upon the trust and  
to the intent and purpose, That they the said Churchwardens  
and overseers of the poor and their successors in the said offices  
for the time being pay out and continue the same at interest  
forever; And Bemore and apply the yearly interest  
thereof at Every Christmas to and amongst such poor  
people of the said parish (as shall not receive Alms  
be relieved by the said parish) as they the said  
Churchwardens and overseers of the poor for the time  
being shall in their discretion think fit, Item I give and  
devise all and Singular my ~~belongings~~ Possessed Lands  
Tenements and hereditaments whatsoever as well  
freeholds as Customary hold unto my loving daughter  
Elizabeth Nicholls and to her heirs and assigns  
forever. And Lastly I give and bequeath unto  
my said daughter all and Singular my Goods Chattels  
and personal Estate whatsoever who it do hereby  
nominate Constitute and Appoint sole Executor of this  
my last will and testament In witness whereof  
I the said Stephen Nicholls have hereunto set my hand  
and seal the two and twentieth day of September  
Anno Domini 1730

Three, by the Reverend Mr Nathaniel Wells Clerke, Minister of acts, the Council of Durham's administration (with the

an inventory & to render a full account of her administration therof when demanded by law required.

SHOW ALL YH/171 by these presents that we I am Dees of the parish of Llandaff  
in the County of Glamorgan widow. Second wife of the  
Deceased named John Williams and Phillip David of the parish of  
Llandaff in the same County Llandaff.

we become bound unto the Right Reverend Father in God John by divine permission Lord Bishop  
of Llandaff in the time of our Lord — pounds of gold and lawful money of great Britain  
to be paid to the said Lord Bishop or his lawful attorney his Esqrs. executors or trustees for the good and  
fifthfull payment whereupon will testify to be made we bind ourselves and each of us by this severally  
for the whole our Heirs & All other persons by these presents sealed with our hands Dated the fifteenth  
day of September in the year of our Lord 1763.

The condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bounden Dees widow  
the aforesaid administratrix of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the  
Deceased Stephen David whilst living the natural lawfull daughter & co-heiress  
named in his last will & Testament of Stephen Nicholls late of the parish of  
Llandaff in the County of Glamorgan & Diocese of Llandaff deceased and administratrix  
with his said wife named of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the  
said Stephen Nicholls deceased

do make or cause to be made; a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the  
said deceased — which have or shall come to her hands

properly or lawfully And the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry  
of the Consistory Court of Llandaff at or before the last — Day of December next  
instant And the same goods chattels and credits — do well and truly  
administering that is to say, do pay the debts of the said deceased which he did owe at his decease  
and then the legacies contained in the said will annexed to the said Letters of Administration so  
to her committed as far as his goods chattels and credits —  
will thence extend and the law require; And further do make or cause to be made a true  
and just Account of her said Administration when she shall be therunto lawfully required;  
And at the rest and residue of the said goods chattels and credits which shall be found upon  
remaining upon her said Account and not otherwise disposed of in the said will  
examined and allowed of by the Judge of the said court for the time being shall distribute and  
dispose in such manner and form as shall be directed by the direction of the said Judge; And  
duly do at all times hereafter clearly acquitt discharge and save her self the above named  
Lord Bishop the said Judge and all other Officers of the said Court, against all persons having  
or pretension to have any Right Title or Interest unto the goods chattels and credits of the said  
deceased; Then this bond to be void and of none effect or else to remain in full force & virtue.
