ordaine this my last will and Testament in manner and formes following

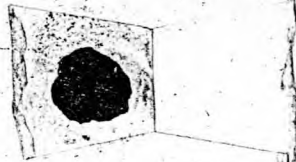
first I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of the Almighty God my maker

Jesus Christ to receive free pardon for all my sinnes as for my body to be buryed
in Christian buriall at the discretion of my executor hereafter nominated

I give and bequeath one shattol lease which I have from Sir Edward Thomas which
is five acres unto my executor George Doore during the lives with in mentioned
Item I give and bequeath unto the same George Doore another shattol lease
under Anthony Turborvil which is four acres ^{halves of which} during the same mentioned
I give and bequeath unto the same George Doore eight and twenty sheepe. Item
I give and bequeath unto my brother law William Doore two stowes and three
stoores and two halves Item I give and bequeath seven acres of land which
I bought of Jonkin Thomas unto my brother John Giffet during the termes of his
naturall life, and after his decease I do give and bequeath this land freely sine
fine for ever unto my executor George Doore, and to his heirs for ever Item
I give and bequeath unto the said George Doore my executor Ten poundes
Item I give and bequeath unto my brother law William Doore Ten poundes
Item I make the said George Doore my sole executor After seeing all other
wills and Testaments In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and
the day and year first above written
