- Noah Brakewell** Holy Cross Roll - Killed in France 12 October 1915.  
No records of Brakewells in 1901 census (Llanb). No record in CWGC  
Glam Gazette Roll of Honour 23.10.1914.
- Richard B Collins** Can find no record of him anywhere.
- Evan Thomas David** Died from effects of gas, 4<sup>th</sup> April 1917 buried in Llanblethian churchyard.  
White cross in chancel of church -22094 Private, 2<sup>nd</sup> Welch Regiment.  
Glam Gazette 23.10.1914. Holy Cross Roll.  
Not recorded GWGC nor 1901 census.
- Hugh Aubrey Fairfield Dunn** 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant, Royal Monmouthshire Royal Engineers.  
Drowned in the river Monnow on 21<sup>st</sup> May 1916, aged 28. Buried with his  
parents in Llanblethian churchyard. Report of his death, inquest (verdict –  
accident) and funeral with full military honours in The Monmouthshire  
Beacon, 26<sup>th</sup> May 1916. He had joined the regiment in November 1915 and  
His youngest brother, Augustus (Guy), would also serve as an officer in the  
RMRE.
- John Robert Collard Dunn** 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant, 1/5 Welch Regt. 53<sup>rd</sup> (Welsh) Division TF, 159 Brigade  
(Jack) Killed in Gallipoli 20<sup>th</sup> August 1915 (Scimitar hill, Suvla Bay) aged 30.  
Second of the five sons of Frederic and Jennet Dunn of The Cross  
CWGC: no grave but name recorded on Helles memorial, Gallipoli
- Francis William Morgan Dunn** 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant 1/5 Welch Regt. (TF)  
(Frank) Killed in action in Gallipoli at Scimitar hill, Suvla Bay on 10<sup>th</sup> August 1915  
aged 29. Third son of Frederic and Jennet Dunn  
No grave, name recorded on Helles memorial, Gallipoli
- The three Dunn brothers are listed on Holy Cross Roll of Honour and on the Grammar school  
memorial. Glam Gazette, 23.10.1914 lists Jack and Frank and also older brother Frank Dunn.  
All the brothers were keen sportsmen and Hugh was a strong swimmer.
- Thomas A J Edwards** 12484 Sergeant, 8<sup>th</sup> Somerset Light Infantry, C Company.  
(Tom) Killed in action, 9<sup>th</sup> April 1917, aged 25  
Son of Samuel John and Elizabeth Edwards of Llanblethian  
No grave but name recorded on Bay 4 of the Arras memorial  
Not on 1901 census. Holy Cross Roll.
- William James** 21379 Private, 2<sup>nd</sup> Welch Regt. 1<sup>st</sup> Division, 3<sup>rd</sup> Brigade in 1914.  
Killed in action in France 9<sup>th</sup> May 1915 (2<sup>nd</sup> battle of Ypres)  
Son of John and Harriet James of Aberthin.  
Not on 1901 census. Holy Cross Roll.
- William Morgan Jenkins** 56281 Private 9<sup>th</sup> Welch Regt.  
Died as a prisoner of war at Quedlinburg hospital, Germany through  
wounds received in action in France 9<sup>th</sup> August 1918, aged 19. (Ramoth)  
Son of William and Margaret Jenkins, The Malthouse, Llanblethian.  
Neiderzwehren cemetery. VIII.A.10  
1901 census. Glam Gazette: 26.7.18, 16.8.18, 1.11.18 Holy Cross Roll.
- Arthur M Jones** 355919 Sergeant 25<sup>th</sup> Royal Welsh Fusiliers (Montgomery and Welsh Horse  
MSM Yeomanry Bn)  
Killed in action 20<sup>th</sup> Sept 1918 Son of Mr & Mrs William Jones, Paradws  
Grave III F 39 Peronne communal cemetery extension.  
Glam Gaz. 4.10.18 Holy Cross Roll. Not in 1901 census.

- Charles Lewis** 110363 Private 9<sup>th</sup> Bn Tank Corps Died of wounds, 23<sup>rd</sup> July 1918, aged 20  
 Son of Alfred and Elizabeth Lewis, Aberthin Road. 1901 Taff St, Cowbridge  
 Grave IV F 4 in Roye New British cemetery.  
 Glam Gaz 2.8.18 9.8.18.  
 Also on Cowbridge war memorial and Holy Cross Roll.
- David Miles** G/1126 Private 2<sup>nd</sup> Royal Sussex Regt. Killed in action 9<sup>th</sup> May 1915 aged 17  
 Son of Angelina Miles of Malthouse, Llanblethian and late David Miles.  
 No grave. Recorded Panel 20/21 Le Touret memorial.  
 Holy Cross Roll. Not on 1901 census.
- Edward Miles** 32482 Private 5<sup>th</sup> South Lancashire Regt. Died of wounds 31<sup>st</sup> Dec. 1917  
 Grave XIV H 25 Dozinghem military cemetery.  
 Holy Cross Roll. Not on 1901 census.
- Aubrey Lloyd Morgan** G/1028 Private 7<sup>th</sup> Royal Sussex Regt. B Coy.  
 Killed in action 21 Oct 1915, aged 21  
 Elder son of Thomas Henry and Emily Anne Morgan of 'Cusop' Llanblethian.  
 No grave. Recorded on Loos memorial Panels 69-73.  
 Holy Cross Roll. Not on 1901 census.
- William Henry Williams** Died on 4<sup>th</sup> February 1919 at Llanblethian. Holy Cross Roll.  
 Not on 1901 census nor recorded by CWGC.
- William Willment** G/1120 Corporal 2<sup>nd</sup> Royal Sussex Regt. D Company 1<sup>st</sup> Division 2<sup>nd</sup> brigade  
 Killed in action 25<sup>th</sup> Sept 1915, aged 27 Son of Fred and Margaret Wilmott of  
 Cowbridge and husband of Ethel May Firman Wilmott 67 Station Rd, Lavender  
 Hill, London.  
 Grave IV E 14 at St Mary's ADS cemetery, Haisnes  
 Holy Cross Roll. Not on 1901 census. CWGC records him as **William Willmot**.
