Space: free 64; other 14.

Present: morn. 11.

Remark: I cannot average the congregation, not knowing that it would be required I have taken no account. The services are alternate Sundays mornings and afternoons, the afternoon is generally considered the largest.

Francis Taynton. Incumbent.

Lewis: perpetual curacy, endowed with £1,200 royal bounty, and £200 parliamentary grant; net income £41; patrons and impropiators, Chapter of Llandaf.

C & C: 1 service, alternately Welsh and English.

I & C: incumbent not resident.

i Llansannor Parish.

Area: 1,798 acres. Popn. 102 males, 106 females: total 208.

7) LANSANNOR OR THAWE PARISH CHURCH.

Endowed: tithe £191. 6.

Space: total 60.

Present: aft 29 + 14 scholars.

Average: general congregation 30; scholars 15.

John Griffith. Rector.

Lewis: discharged rectory, rated at £7. 15. 7½; net income £120, of which £10 are aid as a modus for the Llansannor House demesne; patron J. Bailey, Esq.

C & C: 1 service, alternately Welsh and English.

I & C: incumbent not resident.

Penline Parish.

Area: 1,784 acres. Popn. 160 males, 178 females: total 338.

(8) LLANFRYNACH

Endowed: Return made in Chapel Return.

Remark: The church is far apart from the inhabitants consequent[ly] not used for public services except in summer months on alternate Sundays in the afternoon when the congregation may average about forty persons.

C & C: sub Llanfrynach: Church served only occasionally; being inconveniently situated, people attend the parochial ~~chapter~~ ^{chapel} of Penline.

I & C: vacant

(9) PENLLYNE CHAPEL.

Consecrated about 1700, because the church is situated far apart from the residences of the inhabitants.

Endowed: land £14; tithe £62; glebe £1. 5.; permanent endowment £19. 19; fees £1.

Space: all.

Present: morn. 30 + 15 scholars; aft. Welsh 6.

Average (12 months): morn. 60 + 20 scholars; aft. 10 Welsh.

Remark: A portion of parishioners who are Church attendants from home at present. The Welsh congregation would be more numerous were they not deterred by great echo of Chapel which I hope to find [have?] remedied shortly.

William Llewellyn. Minister.

Lewis: sub Penllyne: discharged vicarage, rated at £4. 15. 2s., and endowed with £600 royal bounty; patron and impropiator, Earl of Dunraven: tithes commuted for £161. 19., of which £100 are payable to the impropiator, subject to rates averaging £15. 16. 3., and £61. 19., subject to rates that average £10. 3. 1., to the vicar; glebe of quarter of an acre, valued at 5s per annum

C & C: 1 service in English, occasionally in Welsh, by the curate.

I & C: sub Penlloyne: vacant.

(10) NEBO. CALVINISTICK METHODIST.

Erected October 1831.

Space: free 400; other 48; standing 400.

Present: aft. 120; even. 100.

Average: general congregation 100.

Cowbridge Parish.

Area: 96 acres. Popn. 515 males, 551 females: total 1,066.

Consecrated 1850.

Endowed: tithe £17; fees £7; Easter offerings £11.

Space: free 258; other 387.

Present: morn. 173 + 20 scholars; even. 192 + 20 scholars.

Remark: In December last the church was repewed the provision of church room previously to the alteration was 440 of which number 39 were free.

Thomas Edmondson. Minister.

Lewis: no distinct incumbency: originally a chapel of ease to the church of Llanblethian, it is served by the vicar of that parish: rectorial tithes commuted for rent-charge of £17. 3.

C & C: 2 services in English taken by the incumbent.

I & C: see sub Llanblethian [583. 2. 22] below.

ICBS: grant of £150 in 1849.

(12) ENGLISH WESLEYAN CHAPEL.

Erected 1850.

Space: free 31; other 128.

Present: morn. 32 + 14 scholars; even. 31 + 18 scholars.

Average: morn. 60 + 20 scholars.

(13) WELSH WESLEYAN CHAPEL.

Erected 1780.

Space: free 60; other 77; standing 39.

Present: morn. 21; even. 94.

Average: general congregation 60 to 90.

(14) SION CHAPEL LIMES. CALVINISTIC METHODIST.

Erected 1825.

Space: free 120; other 290; standing 200.

Present: morn. 150; aft. 'school'; even. 350.

Average: general congregation 560; scholars 82.

(15) RAMOTH BAPTISTS CHAPEL. PARTICULAR BAPTISTS.

Erected 1816 but rebuild and enlarged 1828.

Space: free 250; other 230; standing 200 between the sittings.

Present: morn. 100; even. 250.

Average (12 months): morn. 150 to 200; aft. school; even. 500.

Remark: A prayer meeting we had yesterday, the minister had to be in another place, which will account for the congregation being less. The average for 12 months is not to much. I have seen a 1,000 in the chapel in the evening before now.

(16) SAINT HILARY PARISH CHURCH.

Endowed: tithe £30; Queen Anne's Bounty £67 per annum.

No other incomes.

Space: free 60; other 80.

Present: morn. 40 + 33 scholars.

Average: morn. always between 70 and 80.

Remark: Only morning service and the attendance of the children is always the same.

Lewis: discharged vicarage, rated at £5. 14. 4½, and endowed with £200 private benefaction and £1,000 royal bounty; patrons and impropiators, the Bishop, Archdeacon, and Chapter of Llandaf: great tithes commuted for £91, with a glebe of 72a. or. 28p, valued at £118 per annum, and the vicarial for one of £33; vicar the lessee of the great tithes and glebe under the appropriators.

C & C: 1 service in English taken by the incumbent.

I & C: incumbent resident; curate's stipend £40.

9 St. Mary Church Parish.

Area: 727 acres. *Popn.* 54 males, 50 females: total 104.

(17) ST. MARY CHURCH PARISH CHURCH.

Endowed: tithe £100; glebe £36; fees £1; Easter offerings 10s.

Space: total 'cir' 60.

Present: morn. 30 + 16 scholars; even. 50.

Average (12 months): morn. 'Cir' 40; even. 'cir' 50.

Remark: This parish and Llandough (which adjoins) are consolidated.

Lewis: discharged rectory, united with that of Llandough [583. 2. 21(36)] rated at £5. 6. 8.

C & C: 1 service in Welsh taken by the incumbent.

I & C: incumbent resident.

10 Flemingston Parish.

Area: 672 acres. *Popn.* 41 males, 38 females: total 79.

(18) FLEMINGSTONE OR ST. MICHAEL ON THE HILL PARISH CHURCH.

Endowed: tithe, gross £68; glebe £39.

Space: free 28; other 35.

Present: morn. 8.

Average: morn. 12 or 14.

Thomas Powel. Curate.

Lewis: discharged rectory, rated at £4. 18. 9.; net income £196; patron, Earl of Dunraven.

C & C: 1 service, alternately Welsh and English.

20 Llanmihangel Parish.

Area: 586 acres. *Popn.* 18 males, 19 females: total 37.

(35) LLANMIHANGLE PARISH CHURCH.

Endowed: tithe £13; glebe £42.

Space: free 20; other 40.

Present: aft. 3.

Present: aft. 7 or 8.

Thomas Powel. Curate.
Cowbridge.

Lewis: rectory not in charge; net income £142, with a glebe house: patron, Earl of Dunraven.

C & C: 1 service alternately Welsh and English taken by the curate.

I & C: incumbent not resident: curate, who has a stipend of £100 for two chapelries, resides at Llanblethian, 1 mile distant.

21 Llandough Parish.

Area: 683 acres. *Popn.* 53 males, 60 females: total 113.

(36) LLANDOUGH (ST. DOCHWY) PARISH CHURCH.

Endowed: tithe £80; glebe £65; Easter offerings £1. 10.

Space: free 12; other about 50.

Present: aft. 40 + 1 scholars.

Average (12 months): morn. about 35; aft. about 53.

Remark: This parish and St Mary Church are consolidated. The services are alternately in the morning and afternoon in this church.

Lewis: discharged rectory with that of St. Mary-church [583. 2. 9(17)] united, rated at £4. 18. 9.; net income £263, with a glebe house: patron, C. R. M. Talbot, Esq.

C & C: at Llandough, 1 service in English: at St. Mary church 1 service in Welsh taken by the incumbent.

I & C: incumbent resident.

22 Llanblethian Parish.

Area: 3,148 acres. *Popn.* 361 males, 406 females: total 767.

[[36A]] LLANBLETHIAN (ST. JOHNS). Vicarage with the annexed parishes of Cowbridge and Welsh St. Donats.

Remark: The Church is situated at one extremity of a Parish 4 miles long. I have been told that the number was as above. I was myself ill at home. The duties are alternately at 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Lewis: discharged vicarage, with the perpetual curacies of Cowbridge [583. 2. 7(11)] and Welsh St. Donatt's [581. 3. 10(20)] annexed, rated at £10. 3. 4.; net income £279; patrons and improPRIATORS, Dean and Chapter of Gloucester; tithes of Llanblethian commuted for £412. 6. 5., of which a sum of £271. 6. 5. is payable to the Dean and Chapter and £141 to the incumbent, who also has a glebe of 55 acres valued at £80 per annum.

C & C: 1 service in English.

I & C: incumbent resident; curate's stipend £40.

(37) ABERTHYN CHAPEL. CALVINISTIC METHODIST.

Erected 1749, rebuilt 1780.

Space: free 200; standing 100.

Present: morn. Sunday School; aft. 100; even. no service.

(38) MAENDY. INDEPENDENTS.

Erected 1802, rebuilt 1842.

Space: free 300.

Present: morn. 150; aft. 60 scholars; even. 160.

Average (12 months): morn. 140; aft. 80 scholars; even. 180.

Area: 897 acres. *Popn.* 91 males, 93 females: total 184.

(39) LISWORNEY PARISH CHURCH.

Endowed: tithe £190.

Space: free 20; other 80.

Present: morn. 40 + 17 scholars.

Lewis: discharged vicarage, annexed to that of Llantwit-Major [583. 2. 15(26)], rated at £4. 7. 3½, and endowed with the great tithes of the parish; tithes commuted for £190, subject to rates averaging £33. 5. 8: glebe of about 3¼ acre. valued at £140.
