ORDER OF PROCEEDINGS

The procession, led by the Trumpeters, will proceed into the Council Chamber in the following Order:

Chief Executive of the County Council
Mrs. Joanna Cory, J.P.
Chaplain to the Incoming High Sheriff
Incoming High Sheriff
H.M. Lord-Lieutenant
Outgoing High Sheriff
Chaplain to the Outgoing High Sheriff
Under-Sheriff

All present being upstanding, a fanfare will be sounded.

All present being seated, the Lord-Lieutenant as Keeper of the Rolls will read the Warrant of Appointment of The High Sheriff of South Glamorgan for 1991-92.

The Under-Sheriff will produce the High Sheriff's Declaration to the Lord-Lieutenant, who will call upon the Justice of the Peace, Mrs. Joanna Cory, to invite the High Sheriff to make his Declaration by reading it out in full. The requisite signatures will then be affixed to the Declaration.

The Lord-Lieutenant will hand the completed Declaration to the Chief Executive of the County Council to be kept by him, with his duplicate of the Warrant which he is required by law to enrol and keep.

At the conclusion of these proceedings, all present being upstanding, the Trumpeters will sound a final fanfare and the Town Clerk will lead those on the dais from the Chamber.

Guests are requested to remain in the Council Chamber until the procession has left and then proceed to the High Sheriff's reception.
