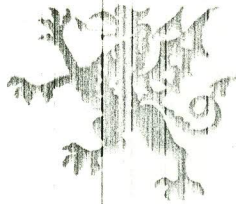


I want to thank you and your society for the invitation to come to Kansas City to explore the possibility of a National for 1992. I look forward to our meeting.

Here is the "RED BOOK" which I briefly described to you when we talked in Victoria. Please look it over and I would suggest you start with Part II of the Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. Let me know before our meeting as to any additional information you may wish me to bring along.

Just a few comments about the following areas of the Book. Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, Part I, page 2, time for the Gymanfa Sessions are set for 2:30 PM and 6:30 PM - times for the past few years have varied. Page 7, Memorial Flowers, since becoming Secretary, I usually indicate to the General Chairman the quantity needed and they are ordered locally. Page 8, Annual Meeting (Venue committees seem to insist on scheduling events during the meeting - we need to take a good look here). Page 13, letterheads, I furnish a reasonable quantity for normal correspondence, but of course I do charge the committee for letter heads used for the mailings. Page 13, I have been assisting the venue committee with the mailings and will do it for you too. Page 15, Discount on Hymnal orders of 100 and over, Due to the increasing cost of paper and printing, it has been necessary to charge \$3.00 for the Hymnals plus the postage or UPS charge. Venue committees over the past 7 years have included cost and income for the Hymnals in their financial report.

Part II, page 13, Ad for preceding Gymanfa Book, we started a mutual exchange of ads in 1986 and it has worked out very well, just furnish the ad without payment, the same arrangement works with The Ontario Gymanfa Ganu Association. I have included a copy of the 1987 program book which I think shows good quality.
