Meeting called to order promptly at 2:00 P.M. by President Lewis. Prayer was offered by Rev. Cerwyn Davies. Quorum was determined.

First order of business: Pat Divers Report-Utica 1996 All the major work has been completed. Some shuttle service arrangements are still in progress. If you are in charge of a group arriving by bus, please notify the Utica committee as to your expected time of arrival.

Executive Director Report: Nelson Llewellyn Membership statistics - section three - blue book

Director Llewellyn, reported a net increase in figures since last August. United States, a 2% increase in life memberships and a decrease in annual memberships. Canada, 8% increase due to 9 new life memberships. Over seas, we lost one membership.

The last page of this report shows the results of the membership status, should the change from east to west be approved for Minnesota.

Reformatted hymnal: 2800 left in storage from the original order of 5000.

A group in Ohio, would like to purchase some of the previous style hymnals. The price of this hymnal has been \$5.00 including postage and handling. We have around 700 of these hymnals left.

Joan Mandry, made a motion that the previous style hymnal be sold in bulk for a cost of \$3.50 each, this price to include postage and handling. Iris Rees, second. Motion passed.

President Lewis, said how very pleased he is with the larger copy of the new reformatted hymnal. The price is \$15.00, including postage and handling. Please tell directors and accompanists we have them available.

BINDERS:

Director Llewellyn, suggested in the future we might want to use a three ring binder for our reports. The reports will be mailed and then each person add the reports to their binder. It was decided that each person purchase a binder for their own use.

Secretary Report: Board of Trustee Meeting, September 1, 1995. Page two. Change report to read: Nelson Llewellyn, stated the age to qualify be 13 to 39. Minutes approved as corrected.

Treasurer Report: WNGGA Financial Status Report section five - blue book

President Lewis, requested an approximate figure in the checking account. Treasurer Miller, said she did not have the checkbook with her, but the figure is around \$32,500.00.

Treasurer, suggested we think about funding for future hymnals. President Lewis, said we need to think about taking a portion from each hymnal sale and put that portion into the memorial hymnal fund. Director Llewellyn, suggested the treasurer work on this and come up with a figure to be presented to the board in September. President Lewis, agreed. No objections from those present. Treasurer, will do this.

Cerwyn Davies, requested an up-date from the director, as to the status of the computer located at the WNGGA Headquarters. Director Llewellyn, reported that he has not purchased a new computer for the headquarters office as yet, however he has purchased his own, which is located in his office at home. Some WNGGA work is being performed on this computer. If Nelson feels this would be the proper hardware for WNGGA, the latest model will be purchased for the headquarters office.

Chairman Cerwyn Davies, read the report of this special
committee. Gwenyth Crysler, President of the Women's
Welsh Clubs of America reported that the Executive Committee
of her organization had agreed to accept the 1994 decision
of the WNGGA. There was no need for further discussion of this
report, which was presented by Rev. Cerwyn Davies. Mrs. Crysler,
extended an invitation to attend the Gymanfa which will be held
at the Welsh Home, on August 11, 1996.
President Lewis, thanked Gwenyth, and asked her to send our
warm regards and appreciation to the members of the board of
the WWCA.

Organization fee schedule: Myfanwy Davies, made a motion to increase the organizational fee to \$50.00. This is to be presented to the membership, for a vote, at the annual meeting in Utica. Megan Lloyd, second. Motion passed.

Endowment/Scholarships - section ll - blue book
Phillips Davies, (chair) A motion was made by Alfred Reese,
that the WNGGA make an annual grant to Cymdeithas Madog and
Welsh Heritage Week, upon receipt of their request. Megan Lloyd,
second. Motion passed.

A motion by Ian Morris, the individual application membership requirement be annual. Roy Morris, second. Motion passed. A motion was made by Phillips Davies, that we eliminate the citizenship requirement on our application. Second, Myfanwy Davies. Motion defeated.

Philli ps Davies, asked members to read the draft to be used for press releases for the Welsh-American newspapers.

Phonetics Book:

President Lewis, feels this is a good help for non-welsh speaking people. He would like to use Judge Jenkins, phonetics and offered to continue work on this project.

President Lewis, asked Jack Pritchard, to share information regarding "on line" communication. Jack Pritchard, is exploring the necessary requirements to obtain this service. The cost is anywhere from \$300.00 to \$700.00 to establish a web sight. Then you have a monthly fee. National Welsh-American Foundation will be meeting in May and Jack Pritchard will explore the possibility of a joint-venture between the two organizations.

Alfred Reese, made a plea to members for information that might be used for the history of WNGGA.

President Lewis, directed those present to refer to the report titled "Preliminary Committee Report". In the absence of Ellis Jones, chairman; committee members, Jack Pritchard and Cerwyn Davies, were asked by President Lewis, to review this report with the board.

Advertisement:

Nelson Llewellyn, indicated the budget for advertising does not cover this type of advertising. Roy Morris, proposed up to \$1000.00 per year, be allocated for advertisement. Iris Rees, second. Motion passed.
