National President advised that, in reply to a request, the sponsoring committee will be allowed the use of \$75.00 worth of National space in Y Drych at their discretion. Mr. Powell will be informed to this effect by the National.

Contact has been made with Mr. Richards of BTA, and some approaches have been made to various Newspapers and some Radio and TV outlets.

Suggested publicity letter supplied by the Hotel to the Secretary was given to the Committee Chairman, and the Committee will contact the Hotel regarding its use.

National Secretary reported on the difficulties encountered in getting stationery to Ontario. Mr. Meadows will check on the whereabouts of material presently in transit and will contact Mr. Blanch with a report of findings.

Miss Thomas suggested contacting the Visitor and Convention Bureau for their assistance in this matter, and Mr. Blanch will contact them as necessary following Mr. Meadows' call.

MINUTES OF MEETING OF GENERAL COMMITTEE OF ONTARIO GYMANFA GANU ASSOCIATION. TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE FORTHCOMING WELSH NATIONAL GUMANFA. 1973. HELD AT THE FOUR SEASONS SHERATON HOTEL. SATURDAY FEB 17th.1973.

Meeting called to Order by President Wm Blanche, 2.60pm.

President. Recretary Treasurer 5 Trustees. 4 National officers and 14 members present. (List attached

Minutes of meeting sat. Jan I3th. 1973 were read by Lyndon Jones acting/sec. in absence of Secretary who had another meeting.

Motion to accept as read. Carried.

Report of Music Committee. given by Gwyn Owen Chairman. Following instructions from last meeting the committee had written to Wales and a letter was read from Mrs Helen Evans. first choice recommended for Conductor. Mrs Evans wrote stating that she had contacted airline re flight and indicated that an Early Bird flight would cost approximately 97.00. she mentioned no definite fee. but would be available and willing to conduct.

Organist. Mr David Low available and willing to serve.

Soloist. Mrs Gaynor Low. also available in neither case was any fee mentioned.

It was the recommendation of the Music Committee that these persons be accepted and voted on.

Discussion followed re remunerations etcand the following decisions made.

on motion by Tom Edwards seconded by John Jenkins,

Mrs Helen Evans was appointed Conductor for the Gymanfa Sessions, at a fee to cover Air Fare, Hotel Accommodation and Remuneration. not to exceed \$800.

Mr David Low Motion Carried.

organist. Suggested fee \$150. Motion to this effect maded by

T.Edwards. seconded John Jenkins.

Motion Carried.

Recommended fee \$50.

That Mrs Gaynor Low to be appointed.

Motion moved by John Martin, seconded by Eluned Thomas,

"That recommendation on floor be amended to read that

fee for soloist be \$75. Motion carried.

Pianist.

Recommended that fee be \$100.

Moved by Rev Elwyn Hughes, seconded by Lyndon Jones .

that fee be set at \$100.

No appointment made.

Motion carried.

Following these appointments, Rev Elwyn Hughes presented to President Wm Blanche a cheque for \$400. doner wishes to remain anonymous. towards defraying expences of conductor. The President asked that best thanks of the Meeting be extended to the donor.

Organ.

Gwyn Owen reported that enquiries had been made regarding a suitable organ, and several Quotations had been aquired. The best suggestion to date was a B.Z.Organ. Description.

It was suggested that now that the Organist had been appointed that he be consulted as to his preferance.

Motion moved by Tom Edwards seconded by Haydn Thomas "That Music Committee be authorized to continue efforts to secure organ, the cost not to exceed \$110. Committee to report back at next meeting.

Motion carried.

National President Owen Roberts thanked meeting for invitation to National Officers to attend.

He then asked permission for National Secretary to put a suggestion before the meeting.

Nat.Sec.Jack Meadows. Youngstown. presented the suggestion for consideration, that in view of rising costs, effecting the income of the Gymanfa, several recent National Committees have set the Registration Fee at \$2.00. mainly due to the fact that as in Salt Lake City in 1971. the usual collections in the sessions, could not be made in the Morman Tabanackle. he suggested that our organization consider raising the Registration Fee to \$2.00..
Matter was deffered. To be discussed further in next meeting.

Question of Accommodation and Rooms for various events was raised by National Officers.

President Wm Blanche informed meeting that 800 rooms had been set aside for National by Hotel.

It was suggested that the arrangement should be watched and carefully checked later.

John Martin brought this matter forward, and it was suggested that the Wives of Ontario Trustees be responsible for the "TeBach" on the Friday evening Aug 3Ist.
