WELCOME to the 33rd Annual National Gymanfa Ganu of the N.G.G.A. sponsored by the Philadelphia Gymanfa Ganu Association, at Philadelphia, Pa., September 3, 4, 5 and 6, 1964

Reverend and dear Sir:

If you think it proper and fitting, we would welcome your gracious assistance in communicating the following message to your congregation in such a way as you deem suitable.

On Sunday, September sixth, at Convention Hall, Philadelphia, you are invited to hear and to see an expected six thousand Welsh-Americans sing in four-part harmony their famed Welsh hymns in either Welsh or English with a devotion and an esthetic sensitivity that are uniquely Welsh.

At two-thirty on Sunday afternoon, and again at seven-thirty on Sunday evening, September sixth, the expected six thousand Welsh voices will sing for about two hours at each session. There shall be no admission charge of any kind.

Dr. Leslie Wynne Evans, considered one of Britain's foremost choral conductors, is flying from Cardiff, Wales, to lead the six thousand voices. This is the first opportunity in ten years for the Delaware Valley residents to enjoy such a uniquely cultural delight.

The Welsh Society of Philadelphia, organized in 1729, and the Women's Welsh Club are sponsoring this thirty-third convention of the National Gymanfa Ganu (guh-MAN-vah-GAN-nee) Association of the United States and Canada so that we may all ecumenically and in Christian fellowship "Come, Sing to the Lord" (Deuwch, Canwn i'r Arglwydd)!
