
Dear Jack:

I had a conversation with Jack Pritchard while attending the Wilkes Barre Gymanfa and he briefly discussed their plans. He mentioned the transportation problems which are similiar to those Utica faced and the resultant expense. I stated that people were certainly appreciative of the available transportation and that based on Utica's experience, they expressed willingness to pay for this added convenience.

Based on the overall prices for '83, there probably is no problem with a \$5.00 registration fee that includes transportation, especially if this is publicized. My reservation is that people signing up on Sunday, particularly those who do so at the afternoon service, are paying a premium. Perhaps on Sunday they could make the registration without the transportation surcharge, for those signing up at the Gymanfa sessions.
